The 2005 production of the movie “The Ultimate Gift” based on Jim Stovall’s book by the same name tells a modern day tale depicting how the unhealthy desire for wealth without the balance of life’s greater “gifts” leads to emptiness and ultimate ruin.

A grandfather’s love for his grandson is shown in leading him on a journey to discover 12 “gifts” that takes his focus off of his self-gratification and points him to the value of others.

As the story unfolds, it is reminiscent of the biblical proverb of the prodigal son. As the son loses everything in his pursuit of the “gifts”, he discovers the value of work, friendship, family, love, having a dream. As he realizes the value of the intangible “gifts” that surpass longing for wealth, he learns that money is to be shared to meet the needs of others.

Although this movie does not directly mention God in the process, we, as believers know that these values and virtues not only cannot be accomplished without the inner work of the Holy Spirit in our lives through a personal relationship with Jesus- The Ultimate Gift, but that ultimately all of these things originate and generate from Him.

Eligibility Process

The project will be under the direction of the Mission Committee of Calvary Baptist Church. The following is a guideline for automatic approval of the Mission Pastor and/or Mission Committee. Calvary sponsored large group trips such as VG, Youth, etc. which is already funded by CBC and duration less than 1 month are not eligible subject to the Mission Committee discretion. These disbursements are subject to available funds that have given specifically for the JUG Project.
