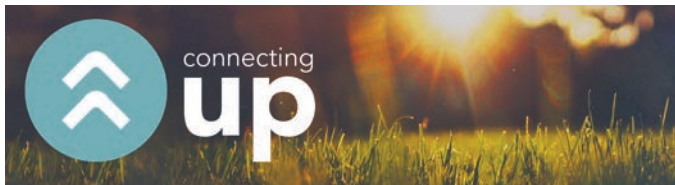

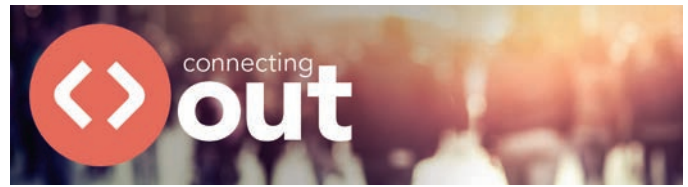


#### TODAY | Calvary Kids Worship Returns
